

CAPE CANAVERAL LADIES MEETING
July 25, 2016

The meeting was called to order by Cozette Merritt at 2:00 p.m.

Chaplain Shirley Jaffe said an opening prayer and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the

Cozette welcomed everyone. It has been six months since the Cape Canaveral Ladies

better and were cheaper. Cozette said also that there are long sleeve white

Ruth Oblack gave the Treasurer's Report. We have gotten the Florida Non-Profit
Corporation title. We are now Cape Canaveral Ladies, Inc. We can ask for
and accept donations now, but these donations are not tax exempt. Our
balance as of June 27, 2016 was \$365.60. We deposited \$100.00 for
nametags; checks cost us \$25.45. So our balance now is \$440.15.

there were any corrections or additions. There were none. Faye Kerstetter
made a motion to accept the minutes. Seconded by Debra Gray. It was
unanimous to accept the minutes.
